Cape Town, South Africa

In their most recent letter, Mark explained the current turbulent and violent unrest in South Africa. He wrote, "There are riots and looting all around the country. The catalyst for the current unrest stems from the imprisonment of former state president Jacob Zuma. Zuma is a Zulu, and the Zulu nation is in an uproar because their man is in prison. In a tribalistic worldview venerated personalities take precedence over the rule of law. To this, add our current lockdown because of the third wave of COVID and the abject poverty that so many are trapped in because of 27 years of socialism, it seems like the perfect storm has arrived. Of course, it is in this context that the gospel often thrives as the unflattering displays of man's raw depravity become the backdrop for the necessity of the cross of Christ! As you pray for us, please pray that there will be many providential gospel opportunities in the days ahead."
