Nursery Facilities (closed during construction) & Cry Room (open)

Our Cry Room, in the south upper room, above the foyer, is open and equipped with a closed-circuit TV for the benefit of mothers who are nursing or whose children need special attention during the service. This Week's Lesson: The Trial and Denial of Jesus

This Week's Memory Verse: Matthew 26:75-27:26

Principle: Every person is accountable for his response to Jesus Christ.

Discuss the following with your child: 1) How did people respond to Jesus differently?

2) How did Jesus respond to the will of God?

Help your children apply biblical truth in the following ways: 1) by thanking God for His sovereignty, and 2) by asking God for help to serve Him completely.

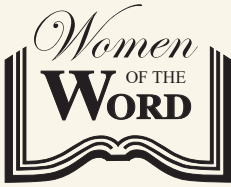
