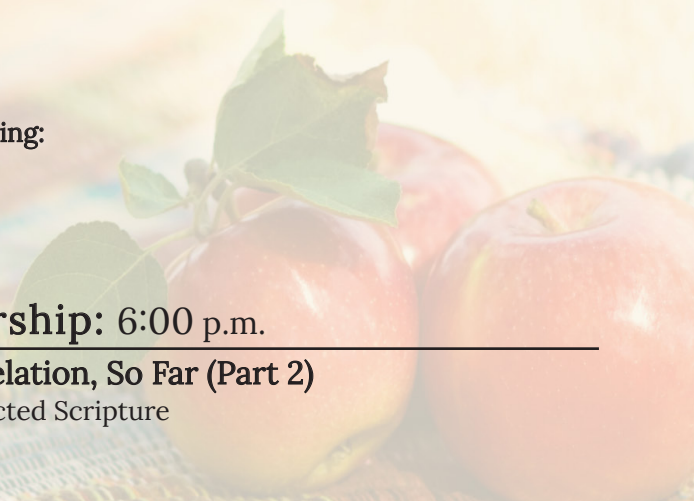

## **Nursery Facilities (closed during construction) & Cry Room (open)**

Indonesia

In their last letter, Paul wrote, “We are getting towards the end of our home assignment in the States. We are already thinking about our return to Indonesia and to the tribe. In July we enjoyed having our daughter, Cori, with us. During that time three of our granddaughters visited us from Texas. It was really nice to have that time with our family. This home assignment we have prioritized getting medical work done. We were able to do most of it during our first three months home, but both Bella and I still have a few more medical needs we need to take care of before we return to the field. We are still planning on returning to Indonesia in September. With the rise of COVID there, the return process has become more complicated. Pray that our trip and transition back to the tribe will be uneventful.”
