Our original plan was to stay here for one year because there were men in the church who have the experience to lead a school. However, when it came down to it, they were not able to take on the responsibility financially. As a result, Renée and I must remain to complete – Lord willing – what we have begun until God brings forward a suitable replacement. Our focus will be to train someone with administrative ability to handle the duties of the registrar, database manager, administrative assistant, and enrollment director. It sounds daunting, but it's a small school, so it is manageable. Please pray as we identify a person to fill this role."
