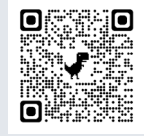

Outreach & Ministry Prayer Update

In his most recent communication, Tim shared, “Spring keeps every school bustling. Achievement testing, inquiries from prospective families, teacher hiring, and Teacher Appreciation Week fill our calendars. Student enrollment also demands significant time at Foothill Christian Academy (FCA). Though our current enrollment stands at 54, strong indicators suggest continued growth. Foothill Bible Church (FBC) boasts many young families, some of whom were waiting to see the school’s success before enrolling their children. Now, several of these families are ready to enroll next year. The number of preschool-aged children in the church is particularly encouraging. I witness this firsthand while assisting in the 4 and 5-year-old class monthly for my grandson. This class has expanded to nearly 30 students, necessitating a division. These families are enthusiastically embracing FCA and enrolling their children at the earliest opportunity. Our new families aren’t exclusively from the church. For instance, Luke, a new student this year, came from another church, but his family has been attending FBC for the past few months. It’s exciting to see the mutually beneficial growth between the church and the school.”
