Missionaries in Ukraine

Currently in the United States

We are so grateful for your prayers for B. At this point, B is still waiting for a donor heart. B continues to walk as much as he can in order to regain and maintain his strength. After one of his walks, he returned to find a group of doctors making their rounds. They were surprised to see him, mentioning that he is usually out walking when they stop by. B asked if he could simply stand there and listen as they discussed his case. One of the doctors commented that this was the first time they had seen a patient standing and talking with them instead of sitting or lying in bed. For now, B and A continue to wait for the Lord's provision of a donor heart. They sometimes hear the helicopter landing and taking off right above B's room. Each helicopter is a reminder that the Lord's timing is drawing nearer, even as they wait. Thank you for continuing to pray for strength, endurance, a timely match, the heart donor's salvation, and healing of the nerve pain in his leg that sometimes makes it difficult to sleep. We rest in the Lord's perfect wisdom and care.
