Outreach & Ministry Prayer Update

Bruce and Aimee Alvord

Currently in the United States

We just wanted to let you know how it's going since Bruce was discharged from the hospital. Unfortunately Bruce continues to experience confusion, lack of concentration, and anxiety/dread. When we saw the occupational therapist, she said that she has seen hundreds of post transplant patients and most of them say the same thing. In one sense that is a small comfort, but it does not help in day-to-day life.

Obviously we believe that God is good and completely and supremely in absolute control of every second, but Bruce's mind continues to loudly assert to him that he is in danger. He is doing his best to take every thought captive according to God's Word but it is a real fight. The doctors acknowledge the side affect as a real and serious problem but he must stick to the meds schedule or his body will attack the foreign heart muscle in his chest. One of the heavy side effect medications must be taken for six months, (it's been 2 months) but the other for life.

We have a praise, the angiogram through his wrist and into his heart was successful. We received the good news that the results are "normal." We are thankful for God's kindness that there are not further complications!
